The Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) offers a free workshop which focuses on driving retirement. Research suggests that many people will outlive their safe driving lives by 7-10 years. The “Driving Decision” is an interactive discussion highlighting older driver issues. Topics include reporting procedures, relicensing requirements, liability, as well as older driver assessment. Functional impairments and the effects of medications are also discussed. “Driving Decision” attendees will be able to identify the warning signs of unsafe driving, understand RMV policies and procedures, and learn best practices to use when talking with older drivers about their driving. Information on disability plates and placards, the application process, eligibility, as well as a list of placards do’s and don’ts is also provided.
